- 1. Review of 2006 road work projects
 - a. Miscellaneous patching and paving by Martinez Paving: Complete
 - b. V-ditch, French drain and culvert repair on Park Drive: Complete
 - c. 4 Volunteer Work Parties: Complete
- 2. Review of current finances
 - a. Funds available in general fund as of January 11, 2007: \$30,363
 - i. \$45,363 \$15,000 (Park Drive Hold Back)* = \$30,363.
 - 1. *Park Drive Hold Back: As per a vote of the general membership, the Association will hold back \$5,000 a year to fund the eventual repair of the drainage ditch at start of Park drive. Current total of the hold back is \$15,000
 - ii. Funds available in general fund after April 2007: \$45,708
 - 1. \$45,363 \$15,000 (Park Drive Hold Back) = \$30,363 + \$15,345 (April 2007 Contribution) = \$45,708
 - b. Funds available in discretionary account as January 11, 2007: \$3,506
- 3. Selection of 2007 road work projects and priorities
 - a. Membership voted to authorize the Board to hire a paving engineer to assess areas of the roads most in need of repair and to prepare proposals for repairs
 - b. Membership voted to authorize the Board to select road repair projects not to exceed \$5,000
- 4. New business for 2007
 - a. Pam Ashlee of 765 Park Drive (not a member of the Association) appeared at the meeting to notify the Association that she has a proscriptive easement that gives her a right to access the "Emergency Road" near 750 Park Drive
 - i. The consensus of the membership was that the gate on the "Emergency Road" would not be locked
